

MORE COVID-19 VACCINES AVAILABLE

FOR AGES 16 YRS AND OLDER

What do you need to do to pre-register for an upcoming vaccination clinic?

- 1. Call 207-764-1792 and let staff know you would like to sign up for a COVID-19 vaccine.
- 2. Please give them all of the names, ages and phone numbers of those interested.
- 3. Please share if weekdays or evenings work best for you.
- 4. Be on the watch for a call from the clinic with the upcoming appointment date, time and location.

What to expect during your appointment?

- 1. You will receive a registration form to complete, educational materials about the vaccine, a card with the vaccine information and the date you are due for the 2nd shot.
- 2. You must remain on site for 15 minutes as a precautionary measure to watch for any adverse reactions.
- 3. You can enjoy a light refreshment while you wait.
- 4. You will receive an appointment card with the date of your next appointment.

Why are the appointments for the vaccines limited?

- 1. The vaccine is in limited supply, it also has storage and administration requirements such as:
 - a. Only 6 hours to use the entire vial of vaccines, or
 - b. Only 5 days to give out all shots in the vial once removed from the ultra-cold freezer, and
- 2. Max packing our schedule limits the "waste" of unused vaccines.

What if I can't keep my appointment?

1. Please call us just a **soon as you can**, we will work to fill your slot with someone else and reschedule yours at that time.

Must be a patient of the clinic or an enrolled member of the ABM

Must be at least 16
