POSITION TITLE: Covid-19 (ARPA) Classroom Helper

CLASSISFICATION: Part-Time Temporary/Hourly/Per Funding 29.5 hours weekly: August 12, 2024-June 19, 2026

IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: Head Start Director and Educational Coordinator

SUMMARY OF POSITION: As Classroom Helper the employee will work cooperatively with classroom staff in the implementation of all classroom activities and field trips.

EDUCATION (AND PERTINENT EXPERIENCE): High School Diploma or GED, CDA preferred. Three months experience working with 3-5 year old children in a center based program preferred.
